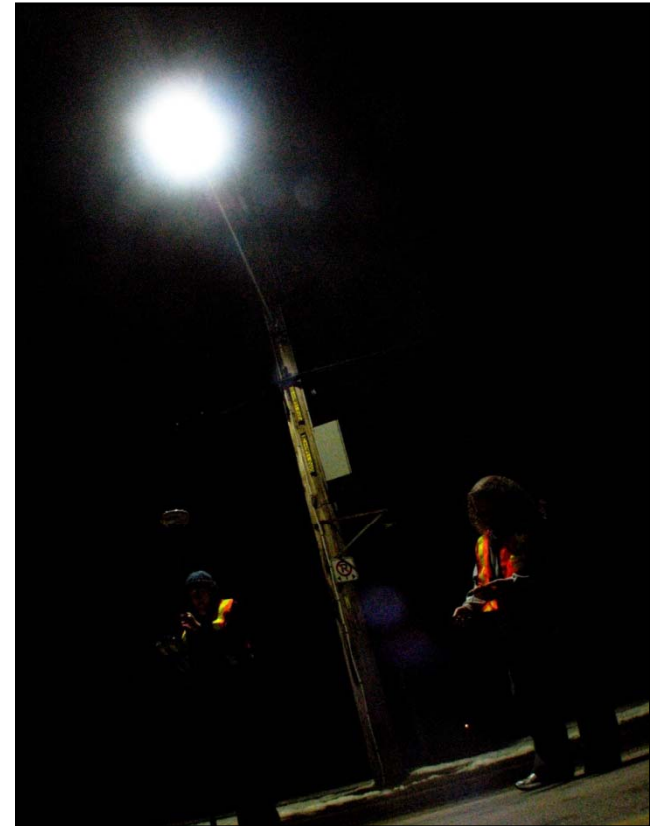


Niagara College students help City of Welland see “green” light at the end of the tunnel
