Visitors from across the Region will receive specially-guided tours and be able to view rare historical displays at the Welland County Courthouse (102 East Main Street at Cross Street), Central Fire Hall (30 Hellems Avenue at Division Street), and Welland Historical Museum (140 King Street).

For the first time this year, the main foyer at Welland Civic Square will be open as an information centre for guests.

In addition to enjoying the architectural wonders of each site, visitors will be privy to historical tales and accounts from years past.

Doors Open Niagara runs Saturday, October 18 – Sunday, October 19 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
