BY-LAW NUMBER 2002 - 134

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2000-175, BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION AND USE OF VEHICLES ON THE WELLAND CANAL MULTI-USE TRAIL AND ADJACENT LANDS

WHEREAS Council deems it necessary and advisable to amend By-law 2000-175, being a By-law to prohibit the operation and use of vehicles on the Welland Canal Multi-Use Trail and adjacent lands, passed by Council on December 5th, 2000.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WELLAND ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That By-law 2000-175 shall be and the same is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) Paragraph 1 is hereby repealed and replaced with the following paragraph 1:

"1. That for the purposes of this by-law, "**vehicle**" means:
an automobile, motorcycle, motor-assisted bicycle, motor scooter, trail bike, dune buggy, mini bike, go-kart, trailer, traction engine, farm tractor, all-terrain vehicle, motorized snow machine or vehicle, and every other kind of motorized vehicle designed for use or capable of transporting a person or persons; save and except a motorized wheel chair operated by a person in need of such a vehicle for the purposes of transport."
 - (b) The following provision shall be added as a new Paragraph 6:

"6. A Police Officer, Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer, Municipal Employee, or Contract Employee, in the course of his employment and duties, is for all purposes of this by-law, exempt from the provisions thereof."
2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of its passage.
