Contact the Clerk's Office if you do not receive a Voter Notification Card by early October. **Electors will be required to present identification showing their name and qualifying address in order to receive a ballot.** Bring your Voter Notification Card and identification with you to your voting location for a seamless voting experience.

PROXY VOTING

If an eligible elector is not able to vote at an Advanced Poll or on Election Day, they may appoint a proxy to vote on their behalf. Appointment for Voting Proxy forms are available at the Office of the City Clerk or online at www.welland.ca/elections/ and must be completed (in duplicate) and received by the City Clerk no later than 5:00 pm on Monday, October 24, 2022, to receive a Certificate to Vote by Proxy.
