**CITY REMINDS PUBLIC TO STAY WARM**

**Welland, ON** - The City of Welland and Welland Public Library Branches are encouraging residents to exercise caution during extreme cold weather alerts. The city's Cold Alert Program offers warming stations at the following city-owned facilities and Public Library Branches when temperatures drop below -15°C.

**Welland Civic Square**, located at 60 East Main Street, Hours: Mon-Fri 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., Sat 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Sun 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

**Welland Community Wellness Complex**, located at 145 Lincoln Street, Hours: Mon-Fri 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Sat 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Sun 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

**Welland Public Library Main Branch**, Located at 50 The Boardwalk, Mon-Thurs 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Fri 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Sat 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Sun 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

**Welland Public Library Diamond Trail Branch**, located at 315 Southworth Street, Mon-Thurs 3:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., Fri Closed, Sat 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Sun Closed.

**Welland Public Library Seaway Mall Branch**, located at 800 Niagara Street, Mon Closed, Tues-Fri 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Sat 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Sun Closed.
