VOTE BY MAIL KIT ASSISTANCE TO ELECTORS IS BEING OFFERED

Welland, ON – This week, Ward 3 residents will have started to receive their Vote-By-Mail kits to cast their vote for the 2021 Ward 3 By-Election.

Starting July 19th, Ward 3 residents may contact the City Clerk’s office to request assistance with completing their vote by mail kits. Staff will answer any questions and explain the instructions via phone or email.

Electors that require special assistance or did not receive a Vote-By-Mail kit in the mail can make an appointment to attend in person by contacting the City Clerk’s office at 905-735-1700 ext. 2153 or emailing election@welland.ca.

At an appointment, electors will still be voting in secrecy. Once verifying they are eligible to vote and on the voter’s list, staff will assist with the Vote-By-Mail kit to the point before marking the ballot. The elector will go behind a secrecy screen and mark their ballot. They will put the completed ballot in the secrecy envelope before dropping it in a sealed ballot box.
