

Welland Transit Advisory Committee Terms of Reference

Objective

The Transit Advisory Committee has been formed to further enhance the community's public transportation service by providing a medium for individuals to offer constructive input toward achieving Welland Transit's Mission Statement:

"To provide a safe, reliable public transportation system, which meets the needs of our community, while innovatively addressing the challenges of the future."

Composition of the Committee

The Transit Advisory committee shall be composed of:

- 1) One City Councillor who is also Chair of the Integrated Services Committee
- 2) One resident with a physical disability
- 3) One person employed in the medical health field – when available
- 4) One person from the senior sector
- 5) One person from the business community
- 6) One person from the educational field
- 7) One Welland Transit Bus Operator
- 8) Resident at large

Each member of the public shall be appointed by Council for the term of Council (four years)

The Welland Transit Advisory Committee reserves the right, if in the event the Transit Advisory Committee required number of members cannot be filled, to request and/or approach individuals from Welland, to sit on the Transit Advisory Committee. These individuals and the Transit Advisory Committee members would still be subject to council's approval

Chairperson

The City Councillor shall act as Transit Advisory Chair and shall chair the meetings.

Voting

A quorum will be comprised of four members.
All members of the committee are entitled to one vote.

Meetings

Meetings shall be held every quarter or at the discretion of the Chair.

Staff Support

The Transit Manager, Office Supervisor, and Operational Supervisor shall be in attendance to address any questions, concerns or initiatives raised by the members.
