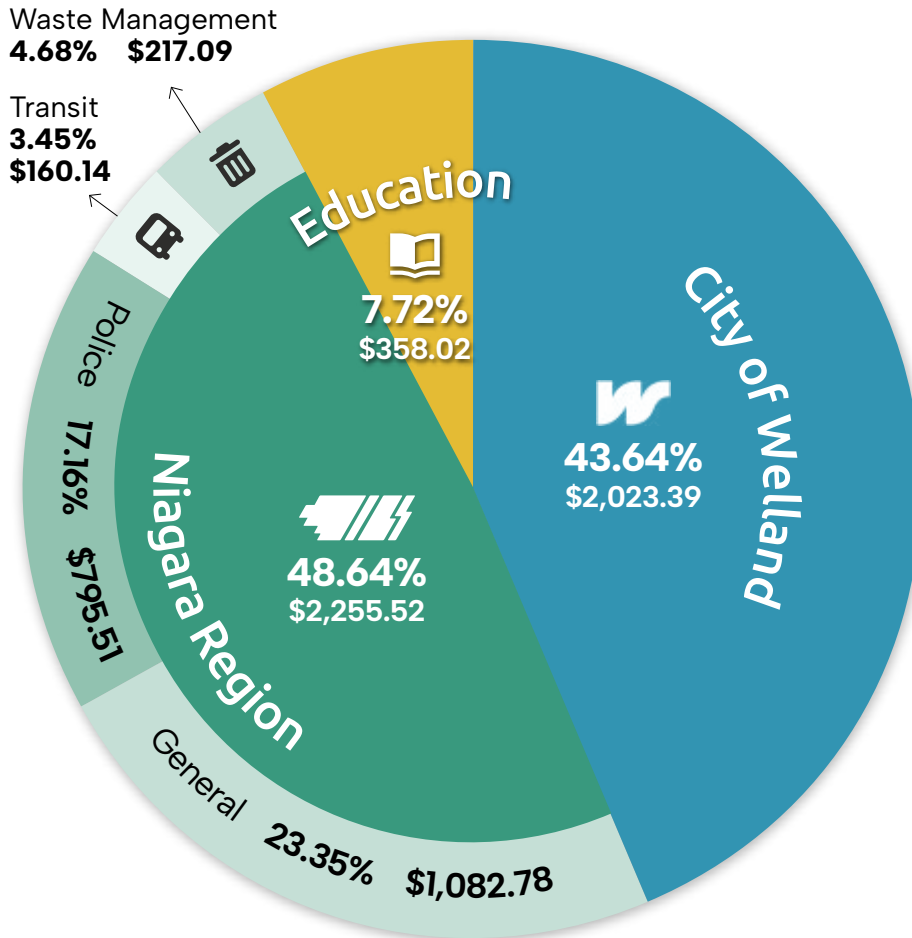


Where do my 2026 property taxes go?

Options for paying on time

Choose the option that works for you:

Pay through your bank

Log in to your online banking and add the City of Welland as a payee:

- Search for "Welland Tax"
- Use your 15-digit account number from your bill (no dashes)

Example: 010-123-45678-0000
→ 010123456780000

Set up automatic payments

Pre-authorized payments make it easy to stay on track with two withdrawal options:

- On each installment due date, or
- Equal monthly payments.

Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC) determines the value and classification of properties across Ontario. Property taxes from 2017 to 2026 are based on 2016 assessed values.
