


Figure 1. Coyle Creek




Figure 2. Draper's Creek



The Niagara Peninsula Conservation Authority (NPCA) is in the process of updating floodplain mapping for Coyle Creek in the Town of Pelham (Figure 1), and Draper's Creek, which flows through the Town of Pelham and the City of Welland (Figure 2).

Members of the Niagara Peninsula watershed community, especially those in the Town of Pelham and City of Welland are invited to attend a fourth Public Information Session, where staff and engineering teams will present the proposed draft maps and seek additional feedback.
