

Notification of Road Closure

Residents & Business Owners of Regional Rd 27 (West Main St) & Surrounding Area.

Please be advised that the next phase of construction of the City's *West Main Street Area Infrastructure Improvements* project is nearing commencement and will require full road closure of Regional Rd 27 (West Main St) within the project limits.

Road closures are required to provide safety to workers and public during the construction of the proposed sanitary and storm sewers within deep trench excavations.

Regional Rd 27 (West Main St) between Niagara St. & Prince Charles Dr. will be closed to through traffic. During this time, both vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be detoured, including, public transportation (School & Transit buses) and emergency vehicles.


This closure is currently scheduled from April 6th to Aug 19th and is subject to change due to inclement weather or delays arising from unforeseen circumstances.

Businesses will remain open during construction. At times, access will be restricted for construction activities work such as removals, services, and new sidewalk and curb.

Crews will do their very best to maintain access to residents and business when possible and in keeping with the conditions of the *occupational health and safety act* however, all property owners in the vicinity of the work zone will be required to find alternate parking, at times, outside of the work zone.

I understand the inconveniences that will be incurred by residents and the community in general however, the tasks required of the men and woman on this project require them to work at depths of almost 30ft below the surface and safety of all workers far out ways the inconvenience that may be incurred by detouring a few moments out of the way.
